

Great Sunnings Farm, Upminster (London Borough of Havering) South Hall Farm, Rainham (London Borough of Havering)

LB Havering is currently (May 2007) reviewing its Local Development Framework and has invited representations as to proposals for site-specific land allocations for housing. The cement manufacturing company, Cemex, owns farmland in the Green Belt in Havering and has responded to this invitation by putting forward two sites on that land: South Hall Farm (Rainham) and Great Sunnings Farm (Upminster). Both sites are currently in agricultural use. The representations by Cemex – submitted on their behalf by planning consultants Drivers Jonas – are available on the LB Havering website at:

In addition to being designated Green Belt, both sites are within the Thames Chase Community Forest area. Mayor of London, Ken Livingstone, has made it clear that he does not think it is necessary to use Green Belt land in order to meet London's housing needs.
